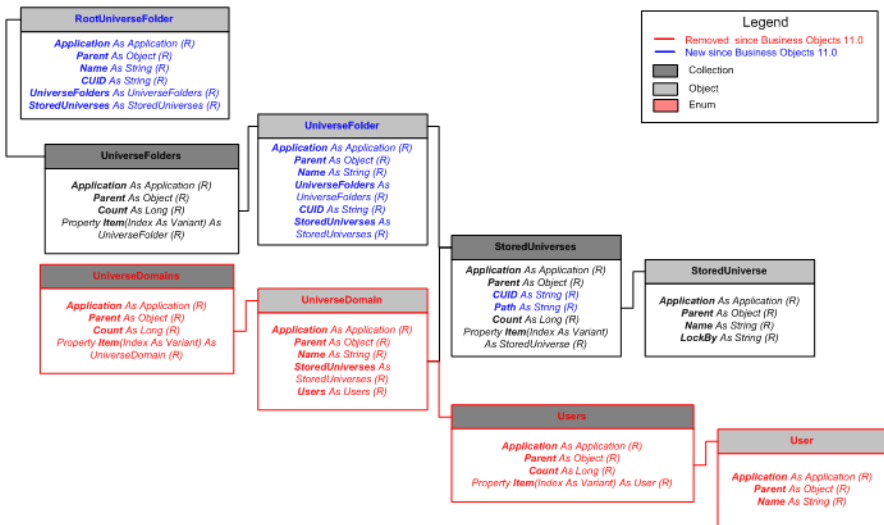

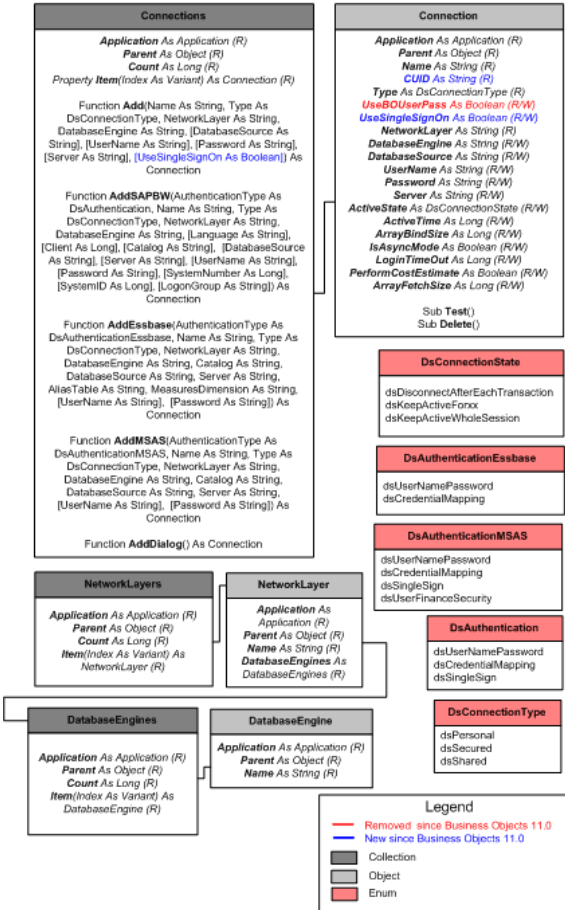

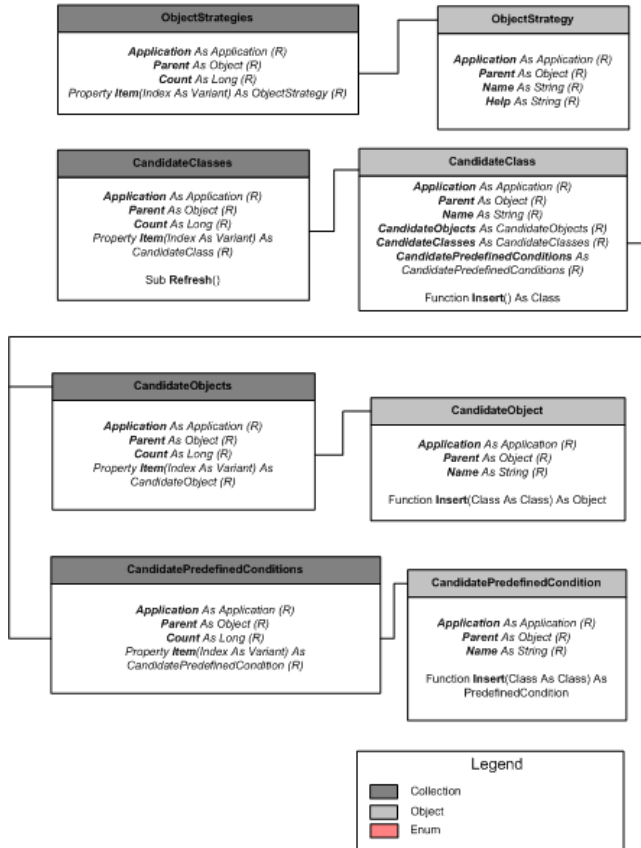

## Designer Object Model LinkedUniverses, SQLOption and ControlOption





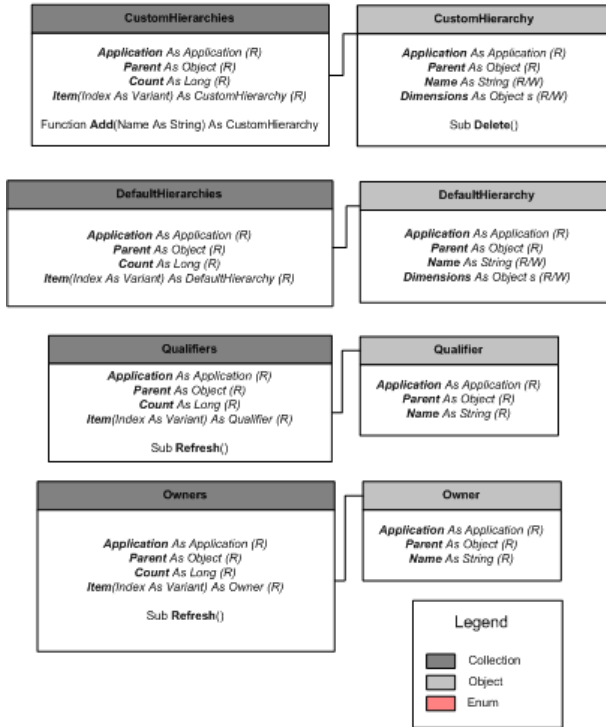

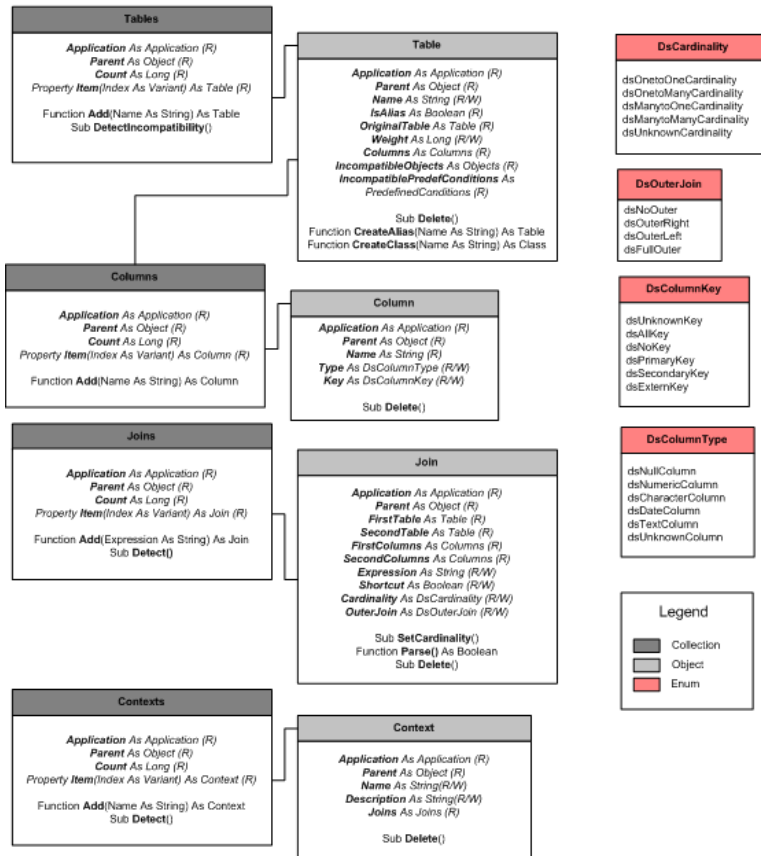

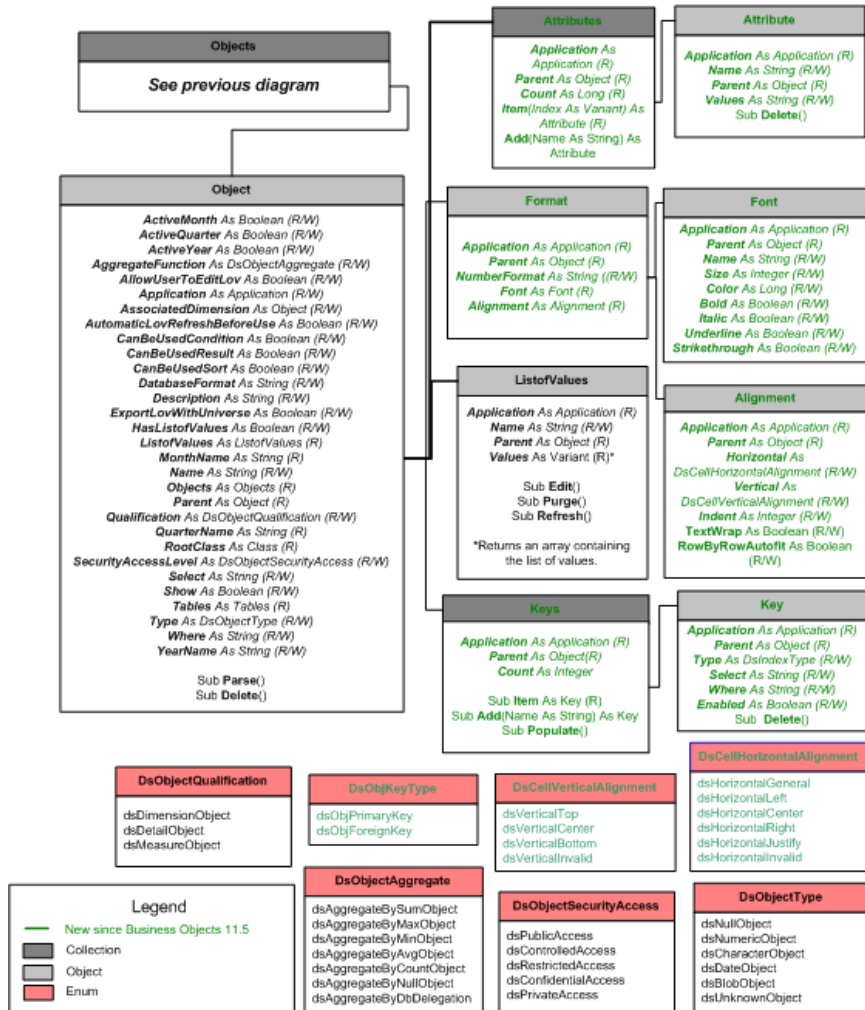
