Payment in the Internet (PY-XX)

Use

This Internet Application Component enables Web users to use the Internet to display their own remuneration statements. The system displays a table containing all of the payroll results for the period specified. Users then choose a payroll result from this table whose remuneration statement they want to display.

The main advantage is that users can display their payroll results as soon as they are available in the R/3 system. Not only does this save time, it also gives users an overview of their payroll results in the period specified.

Prerequisites

The users' payroll data must be available in the R/3 system. In principle, all employees with an ESS user and the appropriate authorization can access their own payroll results. An employee must have an ESS user that is directly linked to their R/3 employee master data, via the *Communication* infotype (105)

Authorizations

SAP delivers a standard activity group that contains all the necessary authorizations. For more information, see [Employee Self-Service \[Ext.\]](#).

Standard Settings and Preassigned Data

In the standard system, the initial screen for this Internet Application Component contains the last available payroll period, and end dates of the current payroll period. Users can change this data in accordance with their requirements.

To set up the ESS users, you have to make various settings in Customizing. For further details, see Customizing *Personnel Management* → *Employee Self-Service*.

To set up the *Payment* Internet Application Component, you have to make various settings in Customizing. For further details, see Customizing for payroll accounting and choose *Payroll: International* → *Forms* → *Remuneration Statement* → *Internet connection for remuneration statement*.

Features

The Internet remuneration statement is the same as the remuneration statement included in the standard system.

Modification Options

You can change the structure of the screen for the Internet Application Component by changing the HTML files in the Internet Transaction Server.

In this way, you can change the layout for all pages by displaying, for example your enterprise logo or the payroll form in the background.

The service name of this application component is *PZ11*. You can find all the relevant data under the service name in the SAP @ Web Studio.

Displaying Payments in the Internet

Use

Using this Internet application component (IAC), you can display your payroll results (remuneration statement) for a requested period.

Procedure

1. Log on to your enterprise's intranet. Choose *Remuneration* → *Payroll results*.
2. Select an accounting period.
 - a) You can display one of the latest payroll results. Enter the amount of accounting results you wish to display in the appropriate entry field.
 - b) Alternatively, you can enter a specific period by entering a start and end date.
3. After you have chosen *Continue*, a list is displayed. Choose one of the entries that you want to display.

The system displays the remuneration statement.
