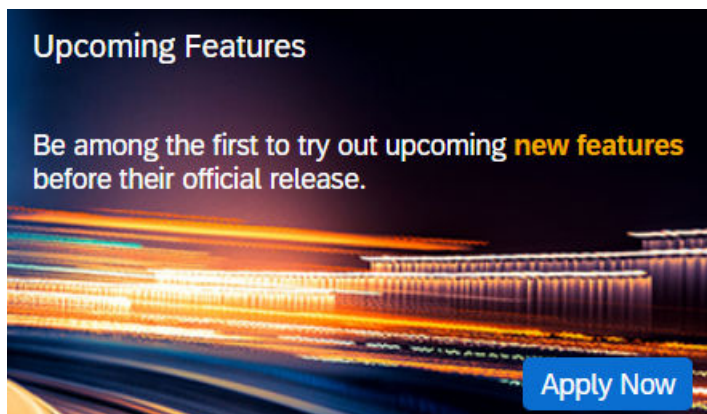
1 Overview

You can try out upcoming new features for the Cloud Studio with the SAP Intelligent RPA testing and feedback program.

SAP may offer access to features that are not generally available and have not been validated and quality assured in accordance with SAP standard processes, and as a customer you may choose to accept this access. These are called beta features. The SAP Intelligent RPA testing and feedback program allows you to access beta features in the Cloud Studio.

Beta features let customers, developers, and partners test new features for SAP Intelligent RPA. The beta features have the following characteristics:

- SAP may require that customers accept additional terms to use beta features.
- To enable the use of beta features in your SAP Intelligent RPA, you need to apply to the testing and feedback program. You do this in your SAP Intelligent Robotic Process Automation Factory tenant by clicking [Apply](#) on the [Upcoming Features](#) tile.

Beta features need to be documented to enable you to use them correctly. However, beta features can change during the testing and feedback period. This Beta Features User Guide will evolve accordingly, and is subject to the same terms of use as the features it describes.
