1 About this Document

This document describes the Connectivity features that are available in SAP BTP.

The availability of some of them may depend on your license agreement with SAP. To illustrate integration with other SAP offerings, the product documentation on the SAP Help Portal might include references to features that aren't included with SAP BTP. Features that are not included in this feature scope description might require a separate license.

2 Features

SAP BTP Connectivity includes the following features and capabilities:

Feature	Description
General	
Access to remote services for SAP BTP applications	Access remote services that run on the Internet or on-premise from your SAP BTP applications.
Support of SAP HANA Development	Create XS destinations for connecting your HANA XS applications to the Internet and on-premise services.
Support of Java and ABAP systems	Establish connections to both Java and ABAP systems in your on-premise landscape.
Cloud Connector for on-premise support	Install and run the Cloud Connector in your on-premise network to establish secure SAP BTP connections.
Cloud Foundry Environment	
Connect applications in the Cloud Foundry environment	Connect any application running in the SAP BTP Cloud Foundry environment to on-premise systems.
Support of HTTP, RFC, TCP	Use HTTP or RFC via secure Cloud Connector tunnel to connect your Cloud Foundry applications to on-premise systems.
	Use HTTP to connect any application running in the SAP BTP Cloud Foundry environment to remote services that run on the Internet.
	Access on-premise systems from a Cloud Foundry application via TCP-based protocols, using a SOCKS5 Proxy.
Create and bind service instances	Create service instances and bind them to a Cloud Foundry application.
Manage destination information in the Cloud Foundry environment	Use the Destination service to manage the destination information required for connecting your Cloud Foundry application to a remote system.
