Feature	Description
Details of Outward Supplies	All outward (sales)supplies invoices uploaded from various source systems can be viewed here.
Details of Inward Supplies	The tax computation content is pre-delivered, and has in-built rules to compute applicable taxes.
Input Credit Reconciliation	Inward (purchase) invoices can be reconciled between source copy of invoices and the supplier copy of invoices (retr from GSTN).
Monthly GSTR3B Return	A view of the outward and inward invoices can be taken as input to file GSTR3B in the GSTN.
Annual Return	A view of some of the sections of GSTR9, of data taken from GSTR3B data and inward/outward invoices, can be taken to file GSTR9 in the GSTN.
Data Transfer Monitor at ECC/S4Hana Level	Feature to check the status of various documents that have been transferred to DCS.
