1 Maintain classification-dependent days' supply limits

On the "Key figures" tab page of the **MRP Monitor**, you can set limit values for range-of-coverage alerts depending on the ABC(D) and XYZ(N) classification.

Preset limit values in the MRP Monitor

Transaction [/SAPL0M/MRP_R](#) enables you to preset the field values on a customer-specific basis.

2 Maintain variants for output results

On the “Material Selection” tab of the **MRP Monitor**, a reduced and customized results table can be read instead of the standard results list in the event of capacity issues or problems with the field size. The system only reads the fields you have defined. For a detailed description of the flow logic, see the user documentation for the **MRP Monitor**.

3 Maintain Customer-Specific Settings
