The intelligent insights option for SAP Logistics Business Network is a highly-customizable data visualization and reporting platform that presents real-time insights on your supply chain execution. This option aggregates data from various options of SAP Logistics Business Network. You can then use stories to describe the data using different kinds of charts, dashboards, and maps. This facilitates you to perform analysis, predictions, and risk control on your supply chain with optimum efficiency.

The intelligent insights option runs on SAP Cloud Platform, which uses the Amazon Web Services infrastructure hosted in a data center in Frankfurt, Germany. The data used in the option is also stored in the data center.

Set up Analytics Features	• Manage integration between intelligent insights and various data sources, for example, the global track and trace option. • Check the mutual trust status between your tenant and the embedded analytics toolsets for SAP Analytics Cloud. • Replicate historical transactional data from the global track and trace option.
Story Management	• Create stories by using the embedded analytics toolsets • Import stories from SAP Analytics Cloud • Edit and delete stories • Filter stories on the story list • Save personalized settings as a tile or view

Model Management	• Create models based on tracked processes from the global track and trace option • Activate models • Edit and delete models • Filter models on the model list
Rule Management	• Define rules to extend tracked processes from the global track and trace option with calculated fields • Edit rules • Filter rules on the rule list
Execution Insights	• Monitor logistics execution based on stories • Filter shipments and locations on the map • Monitor supply chain risks • Navigate to the details page of related documents via hyperlinks • Save personalized settings as a tile or view
