1 What Is Announcement of Legal Changes?

Keep up-to-date with upcoming legal changes.

The Announcement of Legal Changes app helps you to stay compliant by providing an overview of upcoming legal changes. You can view the current status by SAP and set your company's implementation status for each legal change.

Environment

This app is part of SAP ONE Support Launchpad.

Features

Stay compliant	Set up notifications to find out about legal changes that apply to the products, countries/regions, and components that your company requires.
Plan implementation activities	View the status of an upcoming solution from SAP so that you can plan the required implementation activities in your company. Details on the level of complexity help you to manage your change management activities accordingly.
Track an implementation project	When you start an implementation project for legal changes, you can set a status for each legal change so that you have an overview of the current implementation status in your company.
View the implementation status per system	You can see the implementation status of the SAP Note for a given legal change in one of your systems. This feature means that you don't have to go to that system to check the implementation status manually.


Prerequisites

You can view the actual implementation status of a legal change and its SAP Note in one of your systems. To enable data to be replicated to the app through SAP Solution Manager and the SAP Support Backbone infrastructure, the following prerequisites must be met:

- You use SAP Solution Manager 7.2 SP05 or a later version.
- The ABAP SLD data supplier (RZ70) is configured as described in SAP Note [2188401](#).
- You have implemented SAP Note [2589800](#).

2.1 Viewing In-App What's New Information

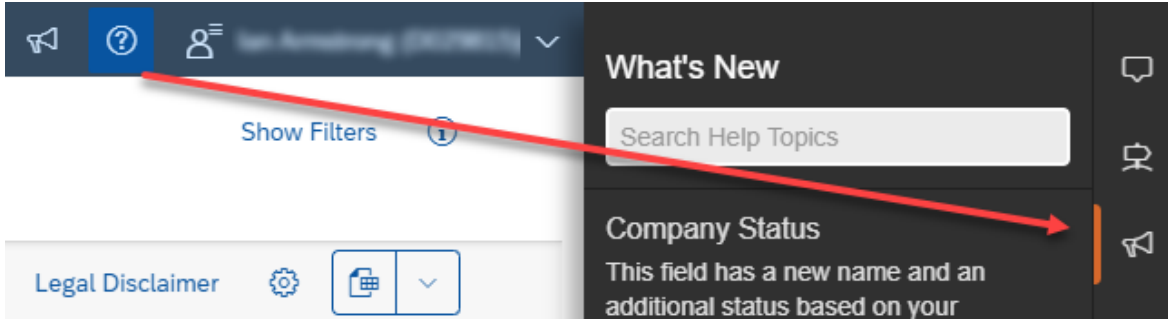
See how to access the details of new and changed features in the app.
