Capture enterprise artifacts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create requirements models manually and by reverse-engineering ReqIF and Word files• Create enterprise architecture models to document goals and strategy, business capabilities, value flows, application and technical landscapes, and other enterprise artifacts• Create BPMN 2.0 business process models manually and by import from SAP BPM• Create conceptual data models• Create physical data models manually, by generation from conceptual or physical data models, or by reverse-engineering from SAP HANA database catalog and HDI files, and from other supported DBMSs• Create NoSQL JSON Schema models manually and by reverse-engineering from JSON Schema and JSON data files• Create data movement models manually and by reverse-engineering from SAP HANA Flow-Graph files• Import artifacts from csv files• Create links between artifacts, including across different types of models
